TONIGHT'S GAME

The Capitals face the Tampa Bay Lightning at Capital One Arena on Tuesday in Game 3 of the 2018 Eastern Conference Final. The Capitals won Game 2, 6-2, at Amalie Arena on May 13 and lead the series 2-0. The Capitals posted a 1-1-1 record against the Lightning during the regular season.

NOTE OF THE NIGHT

Super Carly - With two assists in Game 2, John Carlson recorded his 14th point of the playoffs and set a new franchise mark for points by a defenseman in the postseason. Carlson's 14 points are the second-most among defensemen in the playoffs, and Carlson has recorded a point in nine of the Capitals' 14 games. In 90 career playoff games, which is the second most in franchise history among defensemen, Carlson has 49 points (16g, 33a) and one game-winning goal. Carlson's 16 career playoff goals are tied for the most in franchise history (Hatcher), while his 49 points are third in franchise history. Carlson led all defensemen with 68 points (15g, 53a) this season. Carlson's 68 points was the seventh-highest single season total by a Capital in franchise history. In addition, Carlson became the third Capitals defenseman to lead the NHL in points since 2000 (Sergei Gonchar: 2001-02, 59 points; Mike Green: 2008-09, 2009-10: 73 and 76 points, respectively).

TOP FIVE CAPS FACTS

The Great Eight – Alex Ovechkin finished with a goal and an assist in Game 2, registering his 19th point of the playoffs (10g, 9a). Ovechkin's 19 points are two shy of his own mark in a single postseason (21 points in 2009). The only other Capitals player with more than 10 goals in one playoff year is John Druce, when he scored 14 goals in 15 games in 1990. Ovechkin now has 56 career postseason goals, which is tied with Steve Larmer and Dennis Potvin for the 42nd most in NHL history. Ovechkin is now four goals shy of the franchise record for most in postseason set by John Druce in 1990 (14). Ovechkin is tied for second in the NHL with 10 goals in the playoffs. Ovechkin has recorded eight multi-point games in the playoffs, tied with Mark Scheifele for the most in the NHL. Additionally, Ovechkin is tied for third among active NHL players (min. 20 games played) in career playoff goals per game (0.50) and tied for fifth in playoff points per game (0.98). Among the top 10 active career playoff goal scorers, Ovechkin ranks sixth, and his 0.50 goals per game ranks first among player on that list. In 111 career playoff games, Ovechkin has 109 points (56g, 53a), ranking first in franchise history in playoff games played, goals, points, power play goals (19), power play points (48), game-winning goals (7), shots (504) and second in assists.

Special Teams – The Capitals are 16 for 49 on the power-play this postseason and own the highest power-play percentage (32.6%) of any team remaining in the playoffs. Washington is leading the playoffs in power-play goals (16). The record for the most power play goals in the playoffs is 35 (Minnesota North Stars: 1991). Additionally, Washington has scored a power play goal in 12 of their 14 playoff games. Washington is 9-3 this postseason when they have recorded at least one power play goal.

Holtbeast – Braden Holtby has posted a 10-3-0 record with a 2.04 goals-against average (second among goaltenders currently in the playoffs) and .926 save percentage (tied for third among goaltenders with at least five games played) in 13 games this postseason. His 10 wins are two shy of the Capitals' franchise record for most in a postseason (Olie Kolzig: 1998). In his career, Holtby has posted a

record of 39-33 with four shutouts, a 2.00 goals-against average and a .931 save percentage in a franchise-record 72 playoff games. The Lloydminster, Saskatchewan, native ranks second in NHL playoff history (min. 50 games played) in career save percentage and second in career goals-against average. In addition, Holtby ranks first among active NHL goaltenders (min. 20 games played) in career playoff save percentage and goals-against average. Holtby has allowed two goals or fewer in 47 of his 72 career playoff games and Washington has posted a 33-14 record in those games. Washington and Tampa Bay will play all potential seven games this series on one day of rest. During the regular season, Holtby has played in 160 career games following one day of rest, recording 2.16 goals against average and a .927 save percentage, his lowest goals against average and his highest save percentage of any other combination of days with rest.

Kuz Control - Evgeny Kuznetsov has recorded points in five-straight games (3g, 7a). Additionally, Kuznetsov's 19 points (8g, 11a) are tied with Alex Ovechkin for the most on the team and are two shy of the Capitals' franchise mark for a single postseason (Ovechkin: 21 points in 2009).

Spreading the Wealth - Six different Capitals scored in Game 2 (Alex Ovechkin, Brett Connolly, Lars Eller, Devante Smith-Pelly, Tom Wilson, Evgeny Kuznetsov). That marked the second time this postseason the Capitals have had six different players record a goal in a single game (Game 5 versus Pittsburgh Penguins, Eastern Conference semifinal). According to the Elias Sports Bureau, that's the first time in franchise history the Capitals have had two games with six different goal scorers in a single postseason.

ADDITIONAL CAPITALS NOTES

Big Willy – This postseason, Tom Wilson has nine points (3g, 6a) and has drawn five minor penalties. All of Wilson's points have come at even strength, and his 0.82 even strength points per game leads the Capitals. Wilson recorded 14 goals this regular season, doubling his previous season high of seven set in the 2015-16 and 2016-17 season and his 35 points (14g, 21a) were a career high. Of Wilson's 35 points, 33 came at even strength, while one came on the power play and another shorthanded. Wilson is the only player over the last eight seasons to record 35 points and 185 penalty minutes.

Great Pairs - This postseason, the Capitals have primarily utilized Dmitry Orlov with Matt Niskanen, Michal Kempny with John Carlson and Brooks Orpik with Christian Djoos. At five-on-five, each pair has recorded a positive goals-for percentage (Orlov/Niskanen: 13 goals for, 10 against, 56.52 goals-for percentage; Kempny/Carlson: 6 goals for, 3 against, 66.67 goals-for percentage; Orpik/Djoos: 5 goals for, 1 against, 83.33 goals-for percentage). Additionally, the Orlov-Niskanen pairing has a positive shot attempt percentage (254 shot attempts for, 233 against, 52.16 percent shot attempt percentage) and a positive scoring chance-for percentage (132 scoring chances for, 105 against, 55.70 scoring chance for percentage).

Road Warriors - The Capitals are 7-1 on the road in the playoffs this postseason. Washington leads the League with seven road wins in the playoffs and is tied for the most in franchise history (1998). On the road, the Capitals have outscored opponents 30-17 in the playoffs. Including the regular season, the Capitals have won 12 of their last 13 games on the road.

Rookie Contributions - The Capitals have had six different rookies debut in the playoffs (Nathan Walker, Travis Boyd, Shane Gersich, Chandler Stephenson, Jakub Vrana and Christian Djoos). The Capitals' six rookies ties the franchise mark for the most rookies the Capitals have had participate in the playoffs (1989-90). This postseason, five different Capitals rookies have recorded points, which is a franchise high. Walker recorded an assist on the Capitals' opening goal in Game 6 against Pittsburgh, making him the first Australian to record a point in the playoffs in NHL history. Walker, who became the first Australian to play in the NHL on Oct. 7, recorded a goal in his NHL debut, making him the first Australian to record a point in the regular season.

O From D - Capitals defensemen have combined for 33 points (6g, 27a) in the playoffs, the highest point total among teams remaining in the playoffs. In total, seven different defensemen have recorded a point this postseason, the most of any team still in the playoffs. Washington defensemen combined for 176 points this season, including 138 at even strength. Their 138 even strength points were the most Capitals defensemen have recorded over the last four seasons. The Capitals' 1.68 points per game at even strength ranked sixth in the NHL. Additionally, 26.3 percent of the Capitals' total even strength points (525) came from defensemen, the 10th-highest percentage in the NHL.

Quick Starts - The Capitals have scored the first goal of the game in 11 of their 14 playoff games. Tom Wilson scored a goal 28 seconds into Game 2. That marked the second time this postseason the Capitals recorded a goal within the first minute of a game (Evgeny Kuznetsov: 17 seconds, Game 1 versus the Pittsburgh Penguins), and the Capitals are the only team in the playoffs with two goals under 30 seconds this postseason. Additionally, Washington has 15 goals in the first period, the most in the playoffs.

Tampa Bay Lightning: Head Coach and Player Bios

Head Coach: Jon Cooper

Cooper was named Tampa Bay's eighth head coach on March 26, 2013.

Cooper, 50, begins his sixth season as Lightning head coach and has amassed a 189-120-35 record. Cooper's .599 win percentage is the highest in franchise history. He earned NHL victory No. 100 on April 11, 2015, making him the fifth-fastest coach among those who debuted in the NHL since 2000 to reach the mark. He led the Bolts to the Stanley Cup Playoffs in each of his first three full seasons as head coach, including back-to-back Eastern Conference Finals (2015, 2016) and a Stanley Cup Final (2015). He was a finalist for the Jack Adams Award in 2014, given annually to the NHL's top coach. Cooper joined the Lightning after spending the previous three seasons behind the bench of Tampa Bay's top minor league affiliates, the Norfolk Admirals (2010-12) and the Syracuse Crunch (2012-13), compiling a 133-62-26 (.661) record in 221 AHL games. Cooper's NHL head coaching debut came with the Lightning on March 29, 2013.
