2018 Stanley Cup Playoffs Round 3, Game 5 (May 20) - Vegas Golden Knights 2, Winnipeg Jets 1

The Vegas Golden Knights advanced to the Stanley Cup Final with a 2-1 victory over the Winnipeg Jets. Vegas jumped out to an early lead after **Alex Tuch** scored 5:11 into the game. Winnipeg tied the game and two teams were knotted at 1 heading at the end of the first period. Golden Knights forward **Ryan Reaves** scored what ended up being the game-winning goal in the second stanza, his first goal in a VGK sweater. Vegas held off a strong push from the Jets in the third to clinch the series. **Marc-Andre Fleury** stopped 31 shots en route to his 74th career playoff victory, which ties him for eighth on the NHL's all-time list.

Home Cooking At T-Mobile Arena

The Vegas Golden Knights boast a 6-1 record at T-Mobile Arena, which is the best home record in the 2018 Stanley Cup Playoffs. The Golden Knights lone blemish at home was a 4-3 double-overtime loss to the San Jose Sharks (April 28).

Golden Knights Continue Trend Of Quick Strikes

In the final game against the Winnipeg Jets, the Golden Knights continued its recent trend of scoring early after **Alex Tuch** found the back of the net in Game 5 at the 5:11 mark of the first period, marking the fifth game this postseason, and third in a row, that Vegas has scored in the opening six minutes of regulation. The Golden Knights own a 5-0 mark in those contests.

Advancing To The Stanley Cup Final

Vegas is the sixth team in NHL history to reach the Final in its first playoff appearance – and the third to do so in its inaugural season. The expansion Golden Knights look to become the second team in NHL history to close their inaugural season as champions. The Toronto Arenas ended the first postseason in League history by winning the Cup on home ice and the St. Louis Blues were swept by the Canadiens in 1967-68, when an expansion team was guaranteed a spot in the championship series.

Best Postseason Start in League History

Vegas started with an 8-2 record through its first 10 playoff games – the best record through a franchise's first 10 postseason contests in NHL history. Only two other clubs have required fewer than 14 games to record their eighth all-time playoff win: Florida needed 11

games to win each of their first two series en route to an appearance in the 1996 Stanley Cup Final and Buffalo won eight of their first 13 playoff games from 1973 to 1975.

Vegas Makes More History After Second Round Victory Over San Jose

The Golden Knights became just the third franchise in NHL history to win multiple series in its inaugural season. The first postseason in League history saw the Toronto Arenas win the 1918 NHL Final, a two-game total-goals series, by a 10-7 margin against the Montreal Canadiens before defeating the Pacific Coast Hockey Association's Vancouver Millionaires to win the Stanley Cup. In 1968, the St. Louis Blues defeated the Philadelphia Flyers and Minnesota North Stars to emerge from the all-expansion West Division and advance to the Stanley Cup Final.

Fleury (Still) In Fine Form During Stanley Cup Playoffs

Marc-Andre Fleury made 31 saves as the Golden Knights closed out their series with a 2-1 win over the Winnipeg Jets. It was his 74th postseason victory, which ties him for eighth most all-time. Fleury has had the best postseason numbers of his career, boasting a goals-against average of 1.68 and a save percentage of .947. With the win, he improved to 13-5 in 20 career appearances in the Conference Finals. Overall he has made 478 saves on 505 shots in 15 postseason games this year. Fleury has recorded 14 career postseason shutouts and moved into a tie for sixth place on the NHL's all-time postseason shutouts list. The Sorel, Quebec native is the first goaltender to record four shutouts in a single postseason since 2011, when Vancouver's **Roberto Luongo** and Boston's **Tim Thomas** each registered four. Fleury has a 12-3 record during the postseason and started the and playoffs with a five-game winning streak. It was his third win streak of at least five games within a playoff year. The others came with the Penguins en route to appearances in the Stanley Cup Final: 7-0 in 2008 and 5-0 in 2009.

Marchessault Marching Through The Postseason

Jonathan Marchessault recorded the primary assist on **William Karlsson's** first period goal in Game 4 against the Winnipeg Jets and leads all Golden Knights players with 18 points (8G, 10A) this postseason, matching the NHL record for most points by a player with a franchise in its first-ever postseason. In Game 3, he became the first player in NHL history to score a goal in both the first and last minute of the same playoff game. Marchessault's first goal came 35 seconds into the contest and his second with 2.7 seconds remaining in regulation.

Vegas Golden Knights: Head Coach and Player Bios

Head Coach: Gerard Gallant

Gerard Gallant was named the first head coach in Vegas Golden Knights history on April 13, 2017. He led the Pacific Division to victory during the 2018 All-Star Game and was named a finalist for the Jack Adams Award on April 25, 2018. Gallant is in his seventh season as an NHL head coach after spending parts of six seasons with Columbus (2003-07) and Florida (2014-16) and has compiled a career record of 203-164-4-38. During the playoffs, he owns an 14-7 record (12-3 with VGK, 2-4 with FLA). In his first season with the Golden Knights, he led the team to 109 points, a 51-24-7 overall record and a Pacific Division championship. Gallant spent three seasons (2009-12) as the head coach of the Saint John Sea Dogs of the QMJHL and compiled a 159-34-9 record. He led the Sea Dogs to three first-place finishes, three league final appearances, two QMJHL championships (2011 & 2012) & one Memorial Cup (2011) and was named the QMJHL and Canadian Hockey League Coach of the Year twice (2010 & 2011).

TONIGHT'S GAME

The Capitals face the Vegas Golden Knights at T-Mobile Arena on Monday in Game 1 of the 2018 Stanley Cup Final.

NOTE OF THE NIGHT

The Great Eight – Capitals captain Alex Ovechkin is making his first appearance at the Stanley Cup Final. Ovechkin has scored 12 goals this postseason and is now two goals shy of the franchise record for most goals in the postseason set by John Druce, when he scored 14 goals in 15 games in 1990. In addition, Ovechkin has registered 22 points (12g, 10a) in 19 games and is two points shy of Evgeny Kuznetsov's current mark this postseason (Kuznetsov: 11g, 13a), which is the all-time franchise mark for points in a postseason. Ovechkin, who is fourth among active players with 58 career playoff goals, is tied with Bernie Geoffrion, Luc Robitaille, Mike Modano and Guy Lafleur for 36th in NHL history. Additionally, Ovechkin is tied for third among active NHL players (min. 20 games played) in career playoff goals per game (0.50) and tied for sixth in playoff points per game (0.97). Among the top 10 active career playoff goal scorers, Ovechkin ranks fourth, and his 0.50 goals per game ranks first among player on that list. In 116 career playoff games, Ovechkin has 112 points (58g, 54a), and ranks first in franchise history in playoff games played, goals, points, power play goals (19), power play points (48), game-winning goals (8), shots (527) and second in assists. Ovechkin aims to become the third player in NHL history to score 600 career regular-season goals before winning his first Stanley Cup (Luc Robitaille: 620 goals before 2002 Cup; Dave Andreychuk 634 goals before 2004 Cup). Additionally, Ovechkin can become the 16th player in NHL history to play at least 1,000 career regular-season games before winning his first Cup and the second to do so with the team for which he has played at least 1,000 games (Steve Yzerman with Detroit). He also seeks to become the ninth player to have 1,000 career points before capturing his first Cup. If the Capitals win the series and capture the Stanley Cup, Ovechkin (Moscow, Russia) would become the first Russian player to captain a Stanley Cup champion.

TOP FIVE CAPS FACTS

Holtbeast – After recording consecutive shutouts in Games 6 and 7 in the Eastern Conference Final against the Tampa Bay Lightning, Braden Holtby became the second goaltender in franchise history to record consecutive shutouts in the Stanley Cup Playoffs, joining Ollie Kolzig, who did so in Games 4 and 5 of the 1998 Conference Semifinals against the Senators. Holtby's shutout marked his sixth playoff shutout of his career, tied with Kolzig for the most in franchise history. In addition, Holtby became the 27th goaltender in NHL history to record a shutout in a Game 7 and just the fifth to do so to clinch a berth in the Stanley Cup Final. Of those five goaltenders, Harry Lumley and Dominik Hasek also recorded shutouts in Game 6 of their respective series. Holtby is the 13th goaltender in NHL history to post two consecutive shutouts in elimination games. Holtby improved to 3-4 in seven career Game 7 appearances with a 1.81 goals against average, a .934 save percentage and a shutout. New York Rangers goaltender Henrik Lundqvist (6-2) is the only active NHL goaltender with more career Game 7 appearances. Holtby also improved his record to 8-5 in elimination games with a 1.73 goals against average, a .937 save percentage and two shutouts. In the playoffs this postseason, Holtby is 12-6 with a 2.04 goals against average and a .924 save percentage with two shutouts. Holtby ranks first among all NHL goaltenders since the 1956 season (min. 60 games played) in career save percentage and first in career goals-against average. Holtby has allowed two goals or fewer in 49 of his 77 career playoff games and Washington has posted a 35-14 record in those games.

Kuz Control - Evgeny Kuznetsov recorded an assist in Game 7 of the Eastern Conference Final to extend his point streak to 10 games (6g, 9a), establishing a new franchise record for the longest point streak during the playoffs. Kuznetsov is just the seventh player since 1998 to register a playoff point streak of at least 10 games and the first since 2014. Kuznetsov's 24 points (11g, 13a) lead the playoffs and mark a franchise record for most points in a single postseason. Dating back to Feb. 24, Kuznetsov has 52 points (22g, 30a) in 37 games. Additionally, Kuznetsov is the eighth Russian-born player to record double digits in goals for a single playoff year and the fifth to do so at 25 or younger. In 58 career playoff games, Kuznetsov has recorded 43 points (22g, 21a), tied with Mike Gartner for 12th place in franchise history.

Time to Shine - Andre Burakovsky scored his first two goals of the playoffs in Game 7 of the Eastern Conference Final against the Tampa Bay Lightning to become just the second player in franchise history to score twice in a Game 7, joining Dale Hunter in the 1988 Division Semifinals vs. Philadelphia. Burakovsky recorded 25 points (12g, 13a) during the 2017-18 regular season, his fourth with the Capitals. Among his eight career postseason goals (44 playoff games played) are three multi-goal performances (2g vs. New York Rangers in Game 4 of the 2015 Second Round; 2g at Pittsburgh in Game 6 of the 2017 Second Round).

Super Carly - John Carlson has recorded 16 points (3g, 13a) this postseason, setting a new franchise mark for points by a defenseman. Carlson's 16 points are tied for the most among defensemen in the playoffs. Carlson has recorded a point in 11 of the Capitals' 19 games this postseason. In 95 career playoff games, which is tied for the most in franchise history among defensemen, Carlson has 51 points (16g, 35a) and one game-winning goal. Carlson's 16 career playoff goals are tied for the most in franchise history (Hatcher) among defensemen, while his 51 points are third in franchise history.

Back at the Cup – The 2018 Stanley Cup Final marks the Capitals' second appearance in franchise history. The Capitals faced the Detroit Red Wings in 1998, losing the series 4-0. Joe Juneau led the Capitals in points (1g, 3a) while Brian Bellows led the team with two goals. Goaltender Olie Kolzig stopped 150 of the 163 shots he faced (.920 save percentage). During the 1998 playoff run, Juneau and Adam Oates each led the team with 17 points (Juneau: 7g, 10a; Oates: 6g, 11a).

ADDITIONAL CAPITALS NOTES

New Kids on the Block - Brooks Orpik, who appeared in the 2008 and 2009 Stanley Cup Final with the Pittsburgh Penguins, winning in 2009, is the only Capitals player on the roster who has appeared in the Stanley Cup Final. The Capitals current roster has a combined 1,264 games of playoff hockey experience.

Road Warriors - The Capitals have posted a record of 8-2 on the road in the playoffs this postseason, outscoring opponents 36-20. Washington moved within two road wins of matching the NHL record for most in a postseason.

Dynamic D - Dmitry Orlov's 53.46 shot attempt percentage (394 shot attempts for, 343 against) at five-on-five leads all Capitals defensemen in the playoffs and ranks second among all NHL defensemen with at least 280 five-on-five minutes played this postseason. Additionally, Orlov has been on the ice for 23 of the Capitals' 39 goals at five-on-five during the playoffs, which leads the team, and his 56.30 scoring chance for percentage (192 scoring chances for, 149 against) ranks second on the team (Tom Wilson: 130 scoring chances for, 96 against, 57.52 percentage).

Shots Fired - The Capitals have recorded at least 30 shots in eight of their last nine playoff games. During the postseason, the Caps rank first with 626 shots on goal, while their 31.18 shots per game rank second among playoff teams with at least 13 games played. Washington is led by Alex Ovechkin (80 SOG, first in the NHL), Evgeny Kuznetsov (78 SOG, second in the NHL) and John Carlson (65 SOG, third in the NHL).

Spread it Out - The Capitals have scored 17 goals in the first period (second in the playoffs), 24 in the second period (first) and 22 in the third (first).

Start out Early - Washington has scored six goals within the first five minutes of a game in the playoffs, which ranks first among playoff teams. Additionally, the Capitals have scored eight goals within the first 10 minutes of a game, which is tied for second in the playoffs.

Big Willy – Tom Wilson has recorded 12 points (3g, 9a) in 16 playoff games. Of Wilson's 12 points, 11 have come at even strength, and his 2.59 even strength points per 60 minutes of play are second on the Capitals (Evgeny Kuznetsov: 2.67). Wilson recorded 14 goals this regular season, doubling his previous season high of seven set in the 2015-16 and 2016-17 season and his 35 points (14g, 21a) were a career high. Of Wilson's 35 points, 33 came at even strength. Wilson has drawn nine minor penalties in the playoffs, tied for fourth most in the postseason.
