TONIGHT'S GAME

The Capitals face the Pittsburgh Penguins for the first of four meetings this season. Washington posted a 2-0-2 record against Pittsburgh last season and has a 20-13-7 record against the Penguins since the 2007-08 season. The Capitals hold an all-time record of 95-97-16-9 against the Penguins. Last season, Nicklas Backstrom led the team with 12 points (4g, 8a) against the Penguins, while T.J. Oshie's finished with 10 points (3g, 7a) in four games. Washington has earned a point in five of their last six games against Pittsburgh (3-1-2).

NOTE OF THE NIGHT

Saint Nicky- Nicklas Backstrom recorded his second multi-assist game in a row against the Tampa Bay Lightning on Oct. 9. That marked Backstrom's 127th multi-assist game since he entered the NHL in 2007-08, the second-most in the NHL during that frame, behind Henrik Sedin (132). Backstrom tallied 86 points (23g, 63a) in 82 games last season, ranking second in the NHL in assists and first in assists per 60 minutes (2.52). Backstrom's 86-point season was his third-highest point total of his career. The Gavle, Sweden native finished the season +17, his second-straight season with the mark and set a new career high in game-winning goals (5). In addition, Backstrom ranked second in the NHL in power play assists (27) and led the NHL in power play points (35). Since 2007-08, Backstrom ranks third in the NHL in assists (544), trailing Joe Thornton (559) and Sedin (553).

TOP FIVE CAPS FACTS

Special Success - This season, the Capitals have killed 13 of their 14 penalties and scored on three of their nine power play opportunities. Last season, the Capitals tied for third in the NHL in power play percentage (23.1 percent) and seventh in the NHL in penalty kill percentage (83.8 percent), marking the second-straight year the Capitals have finished in the top ten in both respective categories. The Capitals' 106.98 average special teams index (power play percentage plus penalty kill percentage) over the last three seasons is the highest average in the NHL.

Familiar Foes - Brooks Orpik played in 703 games in 11 seasons with the Penguins. Drafted with Pittsburgh's 18th-overall pick in the 2000 draft, Orpik ranks first in Penguins' franchise history in games played by a defenseman and fourth in penalty minutes (734). Orpik recorded 132 points (13g, 119a) and won a Stanley Cup in 2009. In three games this season, Orpik is averaging 22:22 minutes per game, his highest average over the last six seasons. Matt Niskanen played in 214 games for the Penguins, recording 85 points (19g, 66a), including a career high 46 point season (10g, 36a) in 2013-14. Niskanen is third among all Capitals in ice time (23:44).

Holtbeast - In 159 career home games, Braden Holtby has posted a 103-35-13 record with a .926 save percentage and a 2.14 goals-against average, ranking first and fourth, respectively, among active goaltenders with 100 home games played. Additionally, Holtby has played in the second-most home games over the last three seasons (107) and ranks first in wins (733), five more wins than Pekka Rinne, who is second on the list with 68.

Osh Babe - T.J. Oshie has recorded three goals in his first three games, including a two-goal game against the Tampa Bay Lightning. That marked Oshie's 10th multi-goal game as a Capital. Both of Oshie's tallies against Tampa Bay came on the power play. It marked the first time in 594 games Oshie has scored two power play goals in one game. Last season, Oshie recorded seven power play goals. Oshie co-led the team in goals last season (33), becoming the first player other than Alex Ovechkin to lead the Capitals in goals since 2003-04 (Robert Lang: 29). Oshie was fifth on the team in points (56), first on the team in goals per game (1.63) and second on the team in points per game (2.77). Oshie's 33 goals set a new career high and marked the first time in his career that he reached the 30-goal mark. Oshie also became the first Capitals player to score 30 goals in a season since the 2009-10 season (Alex Semin: 40, Nicklas Backstrom: 33). Oshie scored on a NHL-leading 23.1 percent of his shots, finished seventh in the NHL in plus/minus (+28). The Capitals were 27-3-2 when Oshie earned a point last season.

Multi-Kuzy - Through three games, Evgeny Kuznetsov has eight assists, the highest mark in the NHL. Kuznetsov has recorded multi-assist efforts in two games this season, including a four assist effort against the Montreal Canadiens. Since the 2015-16 season, Kuznetsov has 22 multi-assist games, tied for fifth in the NHL. Since making his debut on March 3, 2010, Kuznetsov has 189 points (53g, 136a) in 263 games.

ADDITIONAL CAPITALS NOTES

Ovechtrick- In the Capitals home opener against the Montreal Canadiens, Alex Ovechkin recorded a hat trick for the second-straight game to lead the Capitals to a 6-1 win. Ovechkin became the first player to open the season with two straight hat tricks in 100 years (Cy Denneny, Ottawa Senators, 1917; Reg Noble, Toronto Arenas, 1917; Joe Malone, Montreal Canadiens, 1917). Ovechkin's hat trick came in the first period and marked his second-straight game scoring three goals in a single period. In the season opener against the Ottawa Senators on Oct. 5, Ovechkin recorded a hat trick in the third period. That makes Ovechkin the third player in NHL history to record two consecutive three-goal periods in two games and the first since 1980 (Rick Martin, Buffalo Sabres, 1975; Darryl Sittler, Toronto Maple Leafs, 1980). The third goal marked Ovechkin's 19th -career hat trick. That ties him with Peter Bondra for the most in franchise history. Ovechkin's 19th hat trick ranks 16th on the all-time list, tied with Gordie Howe, Mark Messier, Dino Ciccarelli and Bondra. Ovechkin also recorded a fourth goal in the second period, his fourth-career four-goal game and his first since Dec. 10, 2013 (vs. Tampa Bay Lightning).

Successful Joey - Australian-national Nathan Walker became the first Australian to play in the NHL when he took the ice against the Montreal Canadiens on Oct. 7, scoring a goal in his NHL debut. The Sydney, Australia, native became the first Australian drafted to the NHL after Washington selected him in the third round, 89th overall, in the 2014 NHL Draft. The rookie has represented Australia at the 2011 IIHF World Championship Division II tournament and at the 2012 World Championship Division 1 Group B tournament. Walker registered 23 points (11g, 12a) in 58 games with the Hershey Bears (AHL) during the 2016-17 season. In the 2015-16 season, Walker was named Hershey's 2016 Man of the Year, Unsung Hero and Most Improved Player.

Setting The Standard - Since the 2014-15 season, the Capitals have the most wins (158) and the most points (344) and have won the Presidents' Trophy as the team with the NHL's best record each of the last two seasons. The Capitals recorded 55 wins in two straight seasons (2015-16: 56, 2016-17: 55), joining the Montreal Canadiens (1975-78) as the only teams in NHL history to win 55 or more games in consecutive seasons. Washington also earned 238 points in the last two seasons, marking the most points in two straight seasons since Montreal recorded 244 points from 1977-79.

October Hunting - In the month of October, Alex Ovechkin has scored 81 goals in 115 games. That's the most goals per game in a month for Ovechkin (0.704).

Another Gr8 Milestone - Alex Ovechkin is just 75 games shy of 1,000 games in his career. Ovechkin, who has led the NHL in goals

since entering the NHL in the 2005-06 season, is looking to become the first player in franchise history to dress in 1,000 games for the Capitals. Since entering the NHL in the 2005-06 season, Ovechkin's 565 goals leads the NHL, and last season he became the 37th player in NHL history to record 1,000 points with one franchise.

Can't Beat Beags or Lars - Jay Beagle ranks sixth in the NHL in face-off win percentage among players with at least 2,000 face-offs taken since the 2014-15 season (56.9%). Beagle also ranks third among active players in face-off win percentage in draws taken in the defensive zone (57.4%) and third in face-off win percentage shorthanded among players with at least 200 draws (55.0%). Lars Eller ranks second in the NHL among players with 40 draws this year in win percentage (66.7%). This season, the Capitals have won 104 of their 189 face-offs, the fourth-best percentage in the League (55.0%).
