Young veteran **Bryan Rust** has shined for Pittsburgh in elimination games. Last round against the Philadelphia Flyers, Rust scored goals in both Games 5 and 6. Those markers ran his career numbers in elimination games to 10 goals, one assist and 11 points in 17 career games. Three times he has scored the game-winning goal in an elimination game, including the winning tally in last year's Game 7 between the Penguins and Capitals at Capital One Arena.

Last round against the Flyers, **Jake Guentzel** enjoyed the game of his life as the Penguins wrapped up the series with a Game 6 victory. Guentzel scored four goals and tacked on an assist for a career-best five points in Pittsburgh's 8-5 win at Wells Fargo Center. Captain **Sidney Crosby** has played a major role in most of the 17 elimination games the Pens have played under **Mike Sullivan** prior to this one. In those games, Crosby has recorded at least one point in 12 of 17 games, producing cumulative totals of three goals, 14 assists and 17 points.

Crosby has been especially good in elimination games since the 3-1 win in Game 6 against the San Jose Sharks in 2016 that clinched the first of the Pens' back-to-back championships. Including that night, Crosby has had at least one point in nine of 11 elimination games:

DON'T SLEEP ON HORNQVIST

If you're looking for another player primed to step up tonight, hedge your bet on **Patric Hornqvist**. He scored again in Game 5, giving him at least one point in eight of his nine games played in the postseason. Stretching back to last spring, Hornqvist has at least one point in 10 of his last 11 playoff games (6G-7A-13PTS).

Hornqvist is up to 11 points (5G-6A) in the playoffs thus far. His playoff career high is 13 points (9G-4A), set in 2016 (24 GP).

Hornqvist has been especially good in his playoff career against Washington, notching seven goals and 12 points in 18 games. He has scored some of his biggest non-Cup-clinching playoff goals against Washington, including the insurance tally in last year's 2-0 Game 7 elimination game victory.

Hornqvist has scored goals in each of his last three elimination games. Those totals obviously include the biggest goal of his life, that Cup-clinching marker in Nashville last June. Here are Hornqvist's numbers in his past three elimination contests:

SID REACHES NEW HEIGHTS

Captain **Sidney Crosby** scored his 66th career playoff goal in Game 5, a tally that put him behind only No. 66 himself, **Mario Lemieux** (76 goals), on the Pens' all-time playoff goals list. Crosby passed **Jaromir Jagr** (65).

That goal was Crosby's 20th point of the playoffs, making him just the eighth player in NHL history to tally 20 points on four or more occasions, joining:

Crosby is up to 184 career playoff points, leaving him one shy of joining the top-10 all-time playoff scorers. His next point will allow him to tie his hero, **Steve Yzerman**, for 10th place at 185 points.

COOL NOTE FROM THE NHL STATS TEAM

Sidney Crosby became the third player to reach the 20-point mark in the 2018 Stanley Cup Playoffs, joining teammate **Jake Guentzel** (10-11—21) and Bruins forward **David Pastrnak** (6-14—20) as of Sunday's games.

The 2018 Stanley Cup Playoffs are just the fourth postseason to feature at least three players with 20-plus points *by the conclusion of the second round*. The others: 1981 (**Mike Bossy**, **Wayne Gretzky**, **Ken Linseman**), 1983 (Gretzky, **Rick Middleton**, **Barry Pederson**) and 1989 (Gretzky, **Tim Kerr**, **Brian Propp**).

STREAK ENDS

Jake Guentzel had his NHL-playoff-high eight-game point streak (9G-8A-17PTS) come to a close. His run was the longest recorded by an NHL player since Los Angeles' **Anze Kopitar** rattled off a 10-game run in 2014 (Apr. 17-May 8, 2014; 4G-11A-15PTS). According to the Elias Sports Bureau, Guentzel's streak is the longest by a Penguins player in a single playoff year since **Jussi Jokinen** had an eight-game run between April 21-May 7, 2014 (5G-3A-8PTS).

TONIGHT'S GAME

The Capitals face the Pittsburgh Penguins at PPG Paints Arena on Monday in Game 6 of the 2018 Eastern Conference semifinals. Washington won Game 5, 6-3 on May 5 to take a 3-2 series lead. The Capitals posted a 2-2-0 record against the Penguins during the regular season.

NOTE OF THE NIGHT

Young V – Capitals rookie Jakub Vrana recorded three points (1g, 2a) in Game 5 and scored his second game-winning goal of the playoffs (Game 2 versus Pittsburgh) to become the first rookie in franchise history to record multiple game-winning goals in a single postseason. Additionally, Vrana became the fourth rookie in franchise history to record three points in a playoff game (Sergei Gonchar, 1995 Conference Quarterfinal versus the Pittsburgh Penguins; Richard Zednik, 1998 Conference Final versus the Buffalo Sabres; Evgeny Kuznetsov, 2015 First Round versus the New York Islanders). Additionally, Vrana's goal with 4:38 left in regulation marked the second time this series the Capitals have scored a game-winning goal in the final five minutes of regulation (Alex Ovechkin: Game 3, 1:07 remaining). According to the Elias Sports Bureau, that marks the first time a team has recorded two game-winning goals in a single series in the last five minutes of regulation (San Jose versus Nashville, 2016).

TOP FIVE CAPS FACTS

Sixth Sense – Washington has won each of its last four series when it led the series 3-2 (2015 ECQF, 2016 ECQF, 2017 ECQF, 2018 ECQF) and is 8-8 all-time. Alex Ovechkin has registered 14 points (7g, 7a) in 14 career Game 6s and Nicklas Backstrom has tallied 12 points (3g, 9a) in 14 career Game 6s. According to the Elias Sports Bureau, when a best of seven series was tied 2-2, the winner of Game 5 holds an all-time series record of 202-54 (78.9%).

Multi-Kuzy - Evgeny Kuznetsov recorded three points (1g, 2a) in Game 5 against the Penguins. That marked his seventh career multi-point game, which ranks fourth on the Capitals since the 2014-15 season, Kuznetsov's first postseason. During the regular season, from March 12 to March 28, Kuznetsov recorded sixth-straight multi-point games (5g, 8a). According to the Elias Sports Bureau, Kuznetsov was the only player with a six-game multi-point streak this season and was the first to complete six-straight games with at least two points since Edmonton Oilers forward Leon Draisaitl (March 14-23, 2017: 3g, 10a). Additionally, Kuznetsov tied the franchise record in most consecutive games with at least two points with Dennis Maruk (1981-82), Mike Gartner (1984-85) and Mike Green (2008-09). Kuznetsov's 13 points (6g, 7a) in the playoffs are tied for second on the Capitals and are tied for eighth in the NHL.

The Great Eight – Entering Game 6, Alex Ovechkin is fourth in the NHL with eight goals in the playoffs and leads the Capitals with 14 points (8g, 6a), which is tied for the sixth most in the NHL. Additionally, Ovechkin is tied for fourth among active NHL players (min. 20 games played) in career playoff goals per game (0.50) and tied for eighth in playoff points per game (0.96). Among the top 10 active career playoff goal scorers, Ovechkin ranks sixth, and his 0.50 goals per game ranks first among player on that list. Ovechkin has 32 points (15g, 16a) in 25 career playoff games against the Penguins.

Holtbeast – Entering Game 6, goaltender Braden Holtby has posted a 7-3-0 record with a 2.16 goals-against average (second among goaltenders currently in the playoffs) and .924 save percentage (fourth among goaltenders with at least three games played currently in the playoffs) in 10 games. In the series, Holtby has a 2.42 goals against average, the lowest goals against average among second-round goaltenders, and a .915 save percentage, the third-highest save percentage in the second-round. Holtby has posted four

shutouts, a 2.02 goals-against average and a .931 save percentage in a franchise-record 69 career playoff games. The Lloydminster, Saskatchewan, native ranks second in NHL playoff history (min. 50 games played) in career save percentage and second in career goals-against average. In addition, Holtby ranks first among active NHL goaltenders (min. 20 games played) in career playoff save percentage and goals-against average. Holtby has allowed two goals or fewer in 43 of his 69 career playoff games and Washington has posted a 29-14 record in those games. During the regular season, Holtby has played in 160 career games following one day of rest, recording 2.16 goals against average and a .927 save percentage, his lowest goals against average and his highest save percentage of any other combination of days with rest.

Super Carly - John Carlson is third among all NHL defensemen with 11 points (3g, 8a) in the playoffs and is now one point shy of tying the Capitals' franchise mark for points by a defenseman in the playoffs (Kevin Hatcher, 1988: 5g, 7a; Scott Stevens, 1988: 1g, 11; Carlson, 2016: 5g, 7a). In 87 career playoff games, which is the second most in franchise history among defensemen, Carlson has 46 points (16g, 30a) and two game-winning goals. Carlson's 68 points (15g, 53a) led the NHL this season and are the seventh-highest single season total by a Capital in franchise history. Carlson became the third Capitals defenseman to lead the NHL in points since 2000 (Sergei Gonchar: 2001-02, 59 points; Mike Green: 2008-09, 2009-10: 73 and 76 points, respectively).

ADDITIONAL CAPITALS NOTES

Cardiac Caps - The Capitals have trailed in a game heading into the third period four times this postseason, and the Capitals have won two of those games. That's the highest win percentage (.500) in games where a team trails heading into the third period in the playoffs.

Rookie Contributions - Shane Gersich, who made his NHL playoff debut in Game 4, is one of five rookies to make their NHL playoff debuts this postseason joining Chandler Stephenson, Jakub Vrana, Christian Djoos and Jakub Jerabek. That's the most rookies the Capitals have had participate in the playoffs since the 1995-96 season (Andrew Brunette, Nolan Baumgartner, Ken Klee, Stefan Ustorf, Jeff Nelson). This postseason, four different Capitals rookies have recorded points, which is a franchise high. The Capitals had nine different rookies on the roster this season (Vrana, Stephenson, Djoos, Jerabek, Gersich, Madison Bowey, Travis Boyd, Nathan Walker and Liam O'Brien), and six rookies recorded their first career point.

O From D - Capitals defensemen have combined for 26 points (5g, 21a) in the playoffs, the third-highest point total among playoff teams in the second round. In total, seven different defensemen have recorded a point this postseason, tied with the Boston Bruins for the most in the playoffs. Washington defensemen combined for 176 points this season, including 138 at even strength. Their 138 even strength points were the most Capitals defensemen have recorded over the last four seasons. The Capitals' 1.68 points per game at even strength ranked sixth in the NHL. Additionally, 26.3 percent of the Capitals' total even strength points (525) came from defensemen, the 10th-highest percentage in the NHL.

Special Teams – The Capitals are 13 for 41 on the power-play this postseason and own the second-highest power-play percentage (31.7%) in the playoffs. Washington is leading the playoffs in power-play goals (13). Additionally, Washington has scored a power play goal in 10 of their 11 playoff games and is four for 14 against Pittsburgh in this series. Washington is 7-3 this postseason when they have recorded at least one power play goal.

Series Breakdown - Entering Game 6, the Capitals have trailed for 80:15 in the series, the third-lowest total among any team that qualified for the second round of the playoffs. Washington has outscored the Penguins 10-6 and generated more scoring chances (93-92) at five-on-five, while the scoring chances are tied 113-113.

Quick Starts - The Capitals have scored the first goal of the game in eight of their 11 playoff games. Additionally, Washington has 12 goals in the first period, tied for the second-most in the playoffs. Evgeny Kuznetsov has scored within the first minute of a period twice this series (Game 1: 17 seconds; Game 5: 52 seconds).

Spread Out Evenly - During the playoffs, the Capitals have recorded 12 goals in the first period, 12 in the second and 15 in the third. Additionally, the Capitals have recorded 364 shots in the playoffs, the second-most in the NHL.

Familiar Foes – This postseason marks the third consecutive season the Capitals and Penguins are meeting in the Eastern Conference semifinals and the 11th postseason meeting between the teams all-time. The Capitals' 11 postseason series against the Penguins is their most against a team in franchise playoff history. In addition, Washington has played more regular-season games (221) against Pittsburgh than any other NHL team.

Caps vs. Pens – Alex Ovechkin has recorded 32 points (15g, 17a) in 25 career playoff games against Pittsburgh. Ovechkin's 14 points (8g, 6a) against Pittsburgh in the 2009 Eastern Conference semifinals is the most points by a Capitals player in a playoff series in franchise history. In 25 career playoff games against the Penguins, Nicklas Backstrom has earned 24 points (8g, 16a). Ovechkin leads

the team in points in this series with six (3g, 3a).
